Homework	
Reading	Children are expected to read 5-10 minutes of their reading book at least five times a week. Additional time should be spent discussing the book e.g. new vocabulary, literal and inferential style questioning (see parent prompts).

Spelling	Children will be allocated spellings each week to learn for a short spelling check the following week. Children are expected to practise their spellings at least 3 times a week using the read, cover, write, check process. Spellings will be from the Superhero Spelling scheme and will relate to the specific spelling patterns and key vocabulary outlined in the English National Curriculum for Year 3. Children can also access Spellingframe, an online tool to support them practice and retain spelling patterns. Logins for this can be found inside their reading record.
Maths	Children are expected to play the Times Table Rockstars Game for 3 minutes four to five times a week. As they progress through the games, a challenge mode develops their rapid recall of times tables. This is to help develop their fluency in mathematics and work towards the statutory times table check at the end of Year 4.
Learning Log	Children are to complete a chosen activity from the year group Learning Log once per half term. This will be a project that uses a range of core skills and explores the wider curriculum. The activities children can choose from will be linked to their learning theme for the next half term or a significant current event. Children can use their homework book to show research, ideas, recording and present final pieces of work for their chosen activity. Children should complete the activity by the deadline outlined on the Learning Log and will be rewarded for effort made, creativity and presentation.
